1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3 4	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2054, sub-§2, ¶ A, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5 and amended by PL 2011, c. 657, Pt. W, §5, is further amended to read:
5 6 7 8 9	A. Only an ambulance; an emergency medical service vehicle; a fire department vehicle; a police vehicle; a Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry vehicle used for forest fire control; a Department of Corrections vehicle as described in subsection 1, paragraph B, subparagraph (6); a school bus as defined in section 2301, subsection 5; and a highway maintenance vehicle may be equipped with a device that provides for alternate flashing of the vehicle's headlights.
