1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRS §2304, sub-§2, ¶A**, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2  
3 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

4 A. One door on the right side near the front for ordinary exits and entrances, which  
5 must be equipped with technology to prevent the door from closing on a person's limb  
6 or other body part; and

8 This bill requires a school bus to be equipped with technology to prevent a school bus  
9 door from closing on a person's limb or other body part.
