1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

7	Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §1596, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2019, c. 262, §1, is repealed.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill eliminates the requirement that health care professionals must report to the
10	Department of Health and Human Services each occurrence of a miscarriage of a fetus of
11	less than 20 weeks gestation.
