1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §1512** is enacted to read:

3 **§1512. Missing persons list**

4 In cooperation with appropriate law enforcement agencies, the Bureau of State Police
5 shall establish and maintain a publicly accessible website that lists all open missing person
6 cases in the State. For each missing person listed, the website must contain a summary of
7 the details of the case, a picture of the missing person and the contact information for the
8 investigating agency.

9 **SUMMARY**

10 This bill requires the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of State Police to establish
11 and maintain a publicly accessible statewide missing persons list.
