2 3	Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §374, sub-§1, $\P K$, as amended by PL 2011, c. 310, §7, is further amended to read:

The manner and amount of compensation to be paid to persons licensed to sell lottery tickets or shares necessary to provide for the adequate availability of tickets or shares to prospective buyers and for the convenience of the general public. Rules adopted by the commission must provide that a person licensed to sell lottery tickets or shares is entitled to a minimum 10% sales commission for each instant lottery game ticket sold and each draw or other terminal-generated game ticket sold;
10 11 12 13 14	SUMMARY This bill provides that rules adopted by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, State Liquor and Lottery Commission must provide that a person licensed to sell lottery tickets is entitled to a minimum 10% sales commission for each instant lottery game ticket sold and each draw or other terminal-generated game ticket sold.
