1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1348, sub-§3**, as amended by PL 2009, c. 161, §3 and  
3 affected by §5, is further amended to read:

4 **3. Delay of notification; criminal investigation by law enforcement.** If, after the  
5 completion of an investigation required by subsection 1, notification is required under  
6 this section, the notification required by this section may be delayed for no longer than 7  
7 3 business days after a law enforcement agency determines that the notification will not  
8 compromise a criminal investigation.

9 **SUMMARY**

10 This bill shortens the time allowed for a delay in notification to residents of the State  
11 of a breach of the security of a system that contains computerized personal information  
12 from 7 business days to 3 business days.
