1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §651, sub-§1, ¶B, as corrected by RR 2013, c. 1, §51, is amended to read:
4 5	B. The property of the State of Maine <u>up to 10% of the total equalized value of the otherwise taxable property in the municipality;</u>
6 7	Sec. 2. Application. This Act applies to property taxes based on the status of property beginning April 1, 2022.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill changes the property tax exemption for state-owned property by requiring the State to pay municipal property taxes on the state-owned property in a municipality that exceeds 10% of the total valuation of taxable property in the municipality.
