1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §403, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 109, §1, is amended to read:
4	3. Requirements. A foreign subpoena submitted issued under subsection 2 must:
5	A. Incorporate the terms used in the foreign subpoena; and
6 7 8	B. Contain or be accompanied by the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all counsel of record in the proceeding to which the subpoena relates and of any party not represented by counsel.
9	SUMMARY
10 11	This bill corrects terminology in the law governing the issuance of a subpoena by a clerk of court in this State upon a person to which a foreign subpoena is directed.
