2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2395, sub-§9 is enacted to read:
3 4	9. Exemption. A commercial motor vehicle hauling a perishable product is exempt from this section.
5	SUMMARY
6 7 8	This bill exempts commercial motor vehicles hauling perishable products from the restrictions on ways requiring special protection by the Department of Transportation counties or municipalities.
