4	provide MaineCare coverage to a person formerly placed in foster care until the person
5	attains 27 years of age.
6	Sec. 2. Rules deadline. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human
7	Services shall adopt the rules under section 1 no later than November 6, 2024.
8	SUMMARY
9	This resolve requires the Department of Health and Human Services to amend its rules
10	by November 6, 2024 to provide MaineCare coverage for a person formerly placed in foster
11	care until the person attains 27 years of age.
