1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and  
3 allocations are made.

4 **HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF**

5 **Office of Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Z199**

6 Initiative: Provides one-time funding to bridge the gap for mental health organizations  
7 participating in certified community behavioral health clinic projects, which have been  
8 funded by federal grants from the United States Department of Health and Human Services,  
9 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration for the past 2 years. This  
10 funding ends on June 30, 2024.
