1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §87-A, sub-§1, ¶D,** as amended by PL 1999, c. 355, §7, is
3 further amended to read:

4 D. The vessel on regularly scheduled ferry operations between Bar Harbor, Maine
5 and Yarmouth, Nova Scotia, provided that the master of such vessel has completed an
6 appropriate number of trips, as established by commission rules and has met any
7 appropriate federal requirements;

8 **Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §87-A, sub-§1, ¶E,** as amended by PL 1999, c. 355, §7, is
9 further amended to read:

10 E. All military ships navigating the Kennebec River to and from the Bath Iron
11 Works Corporation for the purpose of accomplishing overhaul, repair, post
12 shakedown availability and sea trials; and

13 **Sec. 3. 38 MRSA §87-A, sub-§1, ¶F** is enacted to read:

14 F. Noncommercial foreign vessels with overall length of under 200 feet.

15 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill exempts noncommercial foreign vessels of under 200 feet from the
17 requirement that a pilot licensed in this State be on board.
