| 4 | Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §1505, sub-§5 is enacted to read: |
| 5 | 5. Purchase of spirits. A sales representative participating in a tasting event |
| 6 | pursuant to this section may provide spirits being offered for tasting during the event if |
| 7 | the spirits are purchased at a licensed retail establishment. Any spirits provided for a |
| 8 | tasting event pursuant to this subsection must be labeled "for tasting purposes only." Any |
| 9 | remaining spirits provided in conjunction with a tasting event pursuant to this subsection |
| 10 | must be removed from the licensed premises at the conclusion of the tasting event. |

| 12 | This bill amends the law concerning licensed sales representatives at liquor tasting |

events by allowing a sales representative to provide spirits to be sampled under certain conditions and by allowing a sales representative to pour spirits or wine at a liquor tasting
