3 SUMMARY

 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

This bill proposes to establish a program that allows nonpayment of fees and fines in certain circumstances. An individual would not pay certain fees and fines upon request if the Secretary of State determines that the amount of fees or fines creates an excessive financial hardship on the individual. In making this determination, all relevant factors would be considered, including but not limited to: the number of the individual's dependents; the minimum living expenses of the individual and the individual's dependents; the special needs of the individual and the individual's dependents, including necessary travel expenses to and from work; the individual's present income and potential future earning capacity; and the individual's resources, from whatever source.
