1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRS §10014** is enacted to read:

3 **§10014. Student health fees**

4 A postsecondary institution may assess a student a student health fee only if the
5 student has expressly agreed to pay the fee. For purposes of this section, "student health
6 fee" means any fee separately charged to a student for health services, including, but not
7 limited to, access to a health center.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill prohibits a postsecondary institution from assessing a student a student
10 health fee unless the student has expressly agreed to pay the fee.
