1	Be it enacted by the reopie of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA $\S1484$ , sub- $\S3$ , $\PA$ , as amended by PL 2007, c. 627, $\S33$ , is further amended to read:
4 5 6	A. The excise tax on a motor vehicle owned by an individual resident of this State must be paid in the place where the owner resides. <u>If the individual resident of this State has no residing place, the excise tax may be paid directly to the Secretary of State.</u>
7	SUMMARY
8 9	This bill allows an individual resident of the State who has no residing place to pay excise tax on a motor vehicle directly to the Secretary of State.
