1	Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to amend its rules to
2	provide dental services to pregnant women. Resolved: That, by January 1, 2016,
3	the Department of Health and Human Services shall amend Rule Chapter 101, MaineCare
4	Benefits Manual, Chapter II, Section 25 to cover diagnostic, preventive, restorative and
5	periodontic dental services for pregnant women 21 years of age and older. Rules adopted
6	pursuant to this section are routine technical rules pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes,
7	Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

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SUMMARY

9 This resolve requires the Department of Health and Human Services to amend Rule 10 Chapter 101, MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter II, Section 25 to cover diagnostic, 11 preventive, restorative and periodontic dental services for pregnant women 21 years of 12 age and older.
