2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and
3 allocations are made.

4 **HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF**
5 **Office of Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services 0679**

6 Initiative: Provides funding in fiscal years 2017-18 and 2018-19 for primary care patient-
7 centered medical homes and behavioral health providers that provide evidence-based,
8 integrated medication-assisted treatment to patients with opioid use disorder to cover
9 costs of intensive, intermediate and long-term treatment, including, but not limited to, the
10 cost of medication, screening, behavioral health treatment and office visits for 1,000
11 uninsured patients.
