Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of the Final Repeal of Chapter 60: New School Siting Approval, a Late-filed Major Substantive Rule That Has Been Provisionally Repealed by the Department of Education, State Board of Education

1 2	<b>Emergency preamble. Whereas,</b> acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
3 4 5	<b>Whereas,</b> the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A requires legislative authorization before major substantive agency rules may be finally adopted, amended, suspended or repealed by the agency; and
6 7	<b>Whereas,</b> the final repeal of the above-named major substantive rule has been submitted to the Legislature outside the legislative rule acceptance period; and
8 9	<b>Whereas,</b> immediate enactment of this resolve is necessary to record the Legislature's position on final repeal of the rule; and
10 11 12 13	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it
14 15 16 17 18	<b>Sec. 1. Repeal. Resolved:</b> That final repeal of Chapter 60: New School Siting Approval, a provisionally repealed major substantive rule of the Department of Education, State Board of Education that has been submitted to the Legislature for review pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A outside the legislative rule acceptance period, is authorized. <b>Emergency clause.</b> In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this
20	legislation takes effect when approved.
