This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

The Maine State Housing Authority is conducting a pilot project to facilitate rent payment history reporting to credit reporting agencies for purposes of establishing or improving the credit ratings of low-income residential tenants. The authority will provide the results of the pilot project, including data regarding the effectiveness of collecting and reporting rent payment histories, to the Legislature no later than the Second Regular Session of the 132nd Legislature. This bill proposes to make changes to the law based on the results of the pilot project.
