Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

1 SUMMARY

This bill allows the holder of a registration certificate and a set of gold star family
registration plates pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A, section 524-B to be
issued a complimentary license to hunt, trap and fish, including permits, stamps and other
permissions needed to hunt. It also exempts a person with a registration certificate and a
set of gold star family registration plates from the annual motor vehicle registration fee.
