## 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17059, sub-§4, ¶H, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 746, §9 and affected by §10, is amended to read:

H. Does not require the payment of benefits to an alternate payee before the retirement of a member <u>other than a member of the State Employee and Teacher</u>
<u>Retirement Program under chapter 423 and when the payee reaches the member's</u>
<u>normal retirement age</u>, the distribution of a withdrawal of contributions to a member
or other distribution to a member required by law.

9 Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §17059, sub-§5, ¶E, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 746, §9 and 10 affected by §10, is amended to read:

E. The order may not require any action on the part of the retirement system contrary to its governing laws or plan provisions other than the direct payment of the benefit awarded to an alternate payee or the direct payment of the benefit awarded to an alternate payee before the retirement of a member of the State Employee and Teacher Retirement Program under chapter 423 and when the payee reaches the member's normal retirement age.

18 This bill amends the requirements related to a qualified domestic relations order to 19 allow the payment of retirement benefits to an alternate payee before the retirement of a 20 member of the State Employee and Teacher Retirement Program and when the payee 21 reaches the member's normal retirement age.
