3 §14. Community Partnerships with Public School Systems Grant Program

4The Community Partnerships with Public School Systems Grant Program is established5in the department to encourage the creation of partnerships between public and private6colleges and universities, community action agencies or equivalent agencies and public7school systems. The program must provide grants for the purpose of offering services and8addressing issues related to mental health, public health, staff development or other issues9identified by the community or schools.

SUMMARY

This bill establishes the Community Partnerships with Public School Systems Grant Program in the Department of Education to encourage the creation of partnerships between public and private colleges and universities, community action agencies or equivalent agencies and public school systems. It requires the program to provide grants for the purpose of offering services and addressing issues related to mental health, public health, staff development or other issues identified by the community or schools. It also makes a one-time appropriation of \$500,000 in fiscal year 2025-26 to support the program.
