1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRS §1065, sub-§4**, as amended by PL 2003, c. 493, §12 and  
3 affected by §14, is further amended to read:

4 **4. Minors not allowed on premises.** Minors are not permitted to remain on the  
5 premises ~~except when:~~

6 ~~A. The minor is accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or custodian as defined in~~  
7 ~~Title 22, section 4002; or~~

8 ~~B. The licensee does not permit consumption of liquor on the premises for a~~  
9 ~~specific period of time or event.~~

10 **SUMMARY**

11 This bill repeals the exceptions that allow minors to be on the premises of  
12 establishments licensed to sell alcohol as a Class A lounge and clarifies that minors are  
13 not allowed on the premises.
