1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §1862, sub-§14** is enacted to read:

3 **14. Prohibition on oil and natural gas exploration, development and production.**  
4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the director may not permit,  
5 approve or otherwise authorize any oil or natural gas exploration, development or  
6 production in, on or under the submerged and intertidal land owned by the State.

7 As used in this subsection, "development" has the same meaning as in Title 38, section  
8 570-AA, subsection 1; "exploration" has the same meaning as in Title 38, section  
9 570-AA, subsection 2; and "production" has the same meaning as in Title 38, section  
10 570-AA, subsection 3.

11 **Sec. 2. 38 MRSA c. 3, sub-c. 2-C** is enacted to read:

12 **SUBCHAPTER 2-C**

13 **PROHIBITION ON OIL AND NATURAL GAS EXPLORATION,**  
14 **DEVELOPMENT AND PRODUCTION**

15 **§570-AA. Definitions**

16 As used in this subchapter, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following  
17 terms have the following meanings.

18 **1. Development.** "Development" means the activities conducted subsequent to the  
19 discovery of oil or natural gas resources to facilitate the production of those resources,  
20 including, but not limited to, geophysical activities, drilling, platform construction,  
21 pipeline construction and the operation of all onshore support facilities to support those  
22 activities.

23 **2. Exploration.** "Exploration" means the activities conducted to locate oil or natural  
24 gas resources, including, but not limited to, the drilling of wells for the purpose of  
25 locating and determining the size and scope of those resources.

26 **3. Production.** "Production" means the activities conducted subsequent to the  
27 development of oil or natural gas resources including, but not limited to, the removal or  
28 extraction of those resources, related field operations, the transfer of the resources to  
29 onshore facilities, workover drilling and the operation, monitoring and maintenance of  
30 the removal or extraction process.

31 **§570-BB. Prohibition**

32 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a person may not perform  
33 or cause to be performed, and the department may not permit, approve or otherwise  
34 authorize, any oil or natural gas exploration, development or production in, on or under  
35 the waters of the State or that may adversely affect the waters of the State.

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## SUMMARY

2           This bill prohibits a person from performing or causing to be performed any oil or  
3 natural gas exploration, development or production in, on or under the waters of the State  
4 or that may adversely affect the waters of the State.

5           The bill also prohibits the Department of Environmental Protection and the Director  
6 of the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the Department of Agriculture, Conservation  
7 and Forestry from permitting, approving or otherwise authorizing any oil or natural gas  
8 exploration, development or production in, on or under the submerged and intertidal land  
9 owned by the State.

10           It is the intent of this legislation to generally prohibit activities relating to offshore oil  
11 and natural gas exploration, development and production within the boundaries and  
12 jurisdiction of the State, which place the State's coastal communities at economic and  
13 ecological risk from oil spills, and from the pollution caused by routine drilling  
14 operations and onshore industrialization, and threaten the quality of life and livelihoods  
15 of Maine citizens and economically significant industries, including tourism, recreation  
16 and commercial and recreational fishing, and small businesses that rely on a clean and  
17 healthy ocean and clean and healthy beaches.
