14 **SUMMARY**

15 This bill clarifies that a manufacturer or supplier of spirits or a certificate of approval
16 holder may offer mail-in rebates approved by the Department of Administrative and
17 Financial Services, Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations that offer an
18 incrementally greater discount for an increased volume of purchased spirits.
