1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §653, sub-§1, ¶L is enacted to read:
3 4 5	L. For property tax years beginning on or after April 1, 2022, the exemptions provided under paragraphs C and D are increased to \$9,000 and the exemptions provided under paragraphs C-1, D-2 and D-3 are increased to \$10,500.
6 7	Sec. 2. Application. This Act applies to property taxes based on the status of property on or after April 1, 2022.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill increases by 50%, for tax years beginning on or after April 1, 2022, the property tax exemption for all categories of eligible veterans other than paraplegic veterans receiving a \$50,000 exemption for specially adapted housing units.
