### **An Act To Improve Public Transportation in Maine**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Requirements.** The Department of Transportation shall encourage local  
3 volunteer driver networks funded in section 2 to work with regional transportation  
4 providers to leverage the providers' experience, mobility management systems, vehicles  
5 and other resources; seek financial assistance from municipalities and other sources;  
6 charge modest fares; and serve all interested residents. The Department of Transportation  
7 shall coordinate the pilot purchase of service program funded in section 2 with related  
8 efforts of the Statewide Independent Living Council. The Department of Transportation  
9 shall distribute the funding for regional transportation providers in section 2 using the  
10 same formula as current state public transportation funding is distributed: 50%  
11 distributed to urban areas following the United States Department of Transportation,  
12 Federal Transit Administration formula and 50% distributed to rural areas following the  
13 standards governing the Federal Transit Administration formula grants for rural areas  
14 under 49 United States Code, Section 5311, which include the number of square miles in  
15 the service area, the population of the service area and the percentage of low-income  
16 individuals in the service area.

17 **Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and  
18 allocations are made.
