1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §637, sub-§11,</b> as enacted by PL 2019, c. 156, §3 and affected by §4, is amended to read:
4 5 6 7	11. Exception Exceptions. This section does not apply to an employee covered by a collective bargaining agreement during the period between January 1, 2021 and the expiration of the agreement. This section does not apply to municipal firefighters volunteer first responders or substitute teachers.
8 9 10 11	SUMMARY  This bill excludes from the law requiring employers of more than 10 employees to provide earned paid leave municipal firefighters, volunteer first responders and substitute teachers.
