An Act To Protect Towing Operators Providing Emergency Assistance by Allowing the Use of a Flashing Red Light

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
<b>Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2054, sub-§2, ¶F,</b> as amended by PL 2021, c. 26, §1, is further amended by enacting a new subparagraph (6) to read:
(6) A wrecker may be equipped with a flashing red auxiliary light mounted on top of the vehicle in such a manner as to emit a red light over a 360-degree angle. A flashing red auxiliary light on a wrecker equipped in accordance with this subparagraph must be in use whenever the use of a flashing amber light is required under paragraph C, subparagraph (2).
SUMMARY
This bill authorizes wreckers to use a flashing red auxiliary light in conjunction with an amber light, as provided in current law, while servicing, freeing, loading, unloading or towing a vehicle on a public way or in a place where public traffic may reasonably be anticipated.
