4	F. Incorporated nonprofit <del>rural</del> community health centers;
5	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect August 1, 2016.
6	SUMMARY
7	This bill extends to all incorporated nonprofit community health centers the
8	exemption from the sales and use tax currently provided for sales made to incorporated
9	nonprofit rural community health centers.
