1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§16, ¶F,** as enacted by PL 2005, c. 622, §6, is
3 amended to read:

4 F. Incorporated nonprofit ~~rural~~ community health centers;

5 **Sec. 2. Effective date.** This Act takes effect August 1, 2016.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill extends to all incorporated nonprofit community health centers the
8 exemption from the sales and use tax currently provided for sales made to incorporated
9 nonprofit rural community health centers.
