- Sec. 1. Department of Corrections hazard duty stipend. Resolved: That the
 Department of Corrections, and any entity providing services on behalf of the department,
 shall compensate employees eligible for a hazard duty stipend related to the COVID-19
 pandemic. The stipend must:

 1. Be paid retroactively from the time the previous hazard duty stipend was removed;
 2. Continue until the state of civil emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic is
 terminated; and
 3. Be contingent upon the State's receiving COVID-19 pandemic relief funding from
 - 3. Be contingent upon the State's receiving COVID-19 pandemic relief funding from the Federal Government for which the hazard duty stipend for the Department of Corrections could be a qualifying expense.

This resolve requires the Department of Corrections to use federal funding to pay eligible employees a hazard duty stipend related to the COVID-19 pandemic. The stipend must be paid retroactively from when the previous hazard duty stipend ended until the state of civil emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic is terminated.
