1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §662 is enacted to read:
3	§662. Reimbursement to Town of Charleston
4 5 6 7	The Treasurer of State shall annually reimburse the Town of Charleston an amount equal to 43% of the property tax revenue loss suffered by the town during the previous calendar year as a result of the exemption from property tax afforded to the Mountain View Correctional Facility pursuant to section 651.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill requires the Treasurer of State to annually reimburse the Town of Charleston for 43% of the property tax revenue loss suffered by the town in the previous calendar year as a result of the tax exemption that applies to the Mountain View Correctional Facility.
