Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$26,000 in fiscal year 2019-20 for the department to contract with a third party to examine upper payment limit options to increase federally approved limits for services provided under MaineCare. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match.
