**An Act To Allow the Secretary of State To Use an Electronic Lien  
Titling Program for the Purposes of the Maine Motor Vehicle  
Certificate of Title and Antitheft Act**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §602, sub-§4-A** is enacted to read:

3 **4-A. Electronic lien titling program.** "Electronic lien titling program" means a  
4 program that permits the creation and exchange of an electronic record for maintaining lien  
5 information.

6 **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §651-A**, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 645, Pt. A, §7, is amended  
7 to read:

8 **§651-A. Require certificate of lien; certificate of title; certificate of salvage; electronic**  
9 **lien titling program**

10 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Title, the Secretary of State may require a  
11 certificate of lien, certificate of title or certificate of salvage when necessary to perfect a  
12 lien. The Secretary of State may use an electronic lien titling program for the purposes of  
13 this chapter.

14 **SUMMARY**

15 This bill defines the term "electronic lien titling program" under the Maine Motor  
16 Vehicle Certificate of Title and Antitheft Act as a program that permits the creation and  
17 exchange of an electronic record for maintaining lien information. It also allows the  
18 Secretary of State to use an electronic lien titling program for the purposes of that Act.
