1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §837, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 452 and reallocated by c. 583,
3	§15, is repealed.
4	SUMMARY
5	This bill changes the Whistleblowers' Protection Act in order to clarify its scope. The
6	bill repeals a section of the Whistleblowers' Protection Act that was interpreted by the
7	Maine Supreme Judicial Court in Nadeau v. Twin Rivers Paper Company, LLC, 2021 ME
8	16, 247 A.3d 717 as a bar to enforcement of the Act in many cases in which a collective
9	bargaining agreement is in place.
