1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §467, sub-§1, ¶A, as affected by PL 1989, c. 890, Pt. A, §40 and amended by Pt. B, §68, is further amended to read:
4	A. Androscoggin River, main stem, including all impoundments.
5 6	(1) From the Maine-New Hampshire boundary to its confluence with the Ellis River - Class B.
7 8 9	(2) From its confluence with the Ellis River to a line formed by the extension of the Bath-Brunswick boundary across Merrymeeting Bay in a northwesterly direction the Worumbo Dam in Lisbon Falls - Class C.
10 11 12	(3) From the Worumbo Dam in Lisbon Falls to a line formed by the extension of the Bath-Brunswick boundary across Merrymeeting Bay in a northwesterly direction - Class B.
13	SUMMARY
14 15 16	This bill changes from Class C to Class B the classification of the lower Androscoggin River from the Worumbo Dam in Lisbon Falls to a line formed by the extension of the Bath-Brunswick boundary across Merrymeeting Bay.
