## An Act To Clarify the Liability of Funeral Practitioners

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2843-A, sub-§10, ¶F is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	F. A funeral director or practitioner of funeral service who, in good faith, acts upon the instructions of a party that misrepresents that party's custody and control may not be held civilly or criminally liable and is not subject to disciplinary action for acting in accordance with those instructions.
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill provides immunity from disciplinary action and civil and criminal liability
9	for a funeral director or a practitioner of funeral service who, with respect to the remains
10	of a deceased person, acts in good faith upon the instructions of an individual who
11	misrepresents that individual's custody and control of that deceased person.
