1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §1094-B, sub-§1, ¶C**, as enacted by PL 2013, c. 478, §2, is  
3 amended to read:

4 C. The person is notified, in writing or otherwise, by the county jail staff or a law  
5 enforcement officer not to make direct or indirect contact with the specifically  
6 identified alleged victim of the offense for which the person is being detained;

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill amends the law regarding improper contact with a family or household  
9 member prior to the setting of preconviction bail by specifying that a person is guilty of a  
10 violation of that law if notified by a law enforcement officer not to make direct or indirect  
11 contact with the specifically identified alleged victim of the offense for which the person  
12 is being detained and the person intentionally or knowingly makes direct or indirect  
13 contact with the specifically identified alleged victim.
