### An Act To Facilitate the Return of Unclaimed Property

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 33 MRSA §1960**, as amended by PL 2011, c. 477, Pt. H, §1, is further  
3 amended to read:

4 **§1960. Notice and publication of unclaimed property; list upon request**

5 **1. Publication.** The administrator shall publish a notice no later than November  
6 30th of the year next following the year in which unclaimed property has been paid or  
7 delivered to the administrator. The advertisement must be in a form that, in the judgment  
8 of the administrator, is likely to attract the attention of the apparent owner of the  
9 unclaimed property. The form must contain:

10 A. The name of each person appearing to be the owner of the property, as set forth in  
11 the report filed by the holder;

12 B. The last known address or location of each person appearing to be the owner of  
13 the property, if an address or location is set forth in the report filed by the holder;

14 C. A statement explaining that property of the owner is presumed to be abandoned  
15 and has been taken into the protective custody of the administrator; and

16 D. A statement that information about the property and its return to the owner is  
17 available to a person having a legal or beneficial interest in the property, upon request  
18 to the administrator.

19 **2. Publication not required.** The administrator is not required to advertise the  
20 name and address or location of an owner of property having a total value less than \$250  
21 or information concerning a traveler's check, money order or similar instrument.

22 **3. List of apparent owners; upon request.** No later than November 30th of each  
23 year, the administrator shall compile a cumulative list of all apparent owners of property  
24 having a total value of at least \$10,000 that has been paid or delivered to the  
25 administrator at least 36 months prior to the compiling of the list. The list of the apparent  
26 owners, not including the property presumed abandoned and the value of that property, is  
27 a public record, and the administrator shall release it upon written request.

28 **SUMMARY**

29 Under the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act, entities that hold property that is  
30 presumed abandoned must report that property to the administrator, who is the Treasurer  
31 of State, on an annual basis. The report includes the name of each apparent owner of the  
32 presumed abandoned property and the value of the property. This bill requires the  
33 administrator to compile a cumulative list of all apparent owners of presumed abandoned  
34 property having a total value of at least \$10,000 that has been paid or delivered to the  
35 administrator at least 36 months prior to the compiling of the list. The administrator is  
36 required to release the list of apparent owners, without the property presumed abandoned  
37 and the value of that property, upon written request.
