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9 This resolve requires the Department of Health and Human Services to amend its rule 10 Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 97, Private Non-Medical Institution Services, Appendix B to reimburse for non-hospital-based medically supervised 11 12 withdrawal services at no less than \$594.38 per day. The department must amend the rule 13 no later than January 1, 2026.
