1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11161, sub-§2,** as amended by PL 2017, c. 366, §1, is repealed.

3 **Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §11161, sub-§5,** as enacted by PL 2015, c. 262, §1, is repealed.

4 **SUMMARY**

5 This bill repeals the provisions of law allowing the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries
6 and Wildlife to issue permits to use noise suppression devices with firearms while hunting.
