1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6072-C, sub-§6, as amended by PL 2021, c. 52, §16 and affected by §21, is further amended to read:
4 5 6 7 8 9	6. Fee. The application fee for a resident limited-purpose aquaculture license is \$100 and for a nonresident limited-purpose aquaculture license is \$400, except that a municipal shellfish management committee established pursuant to section 6671 may not be assessed an application fee. The application fee is nonrefundable. All fees collected under this subsection must be deposited in the Aquaculture Research Fund established in section 6081.
10	SUMMARY
11 12	This bill provides that a municipal shellfish management committee may not be assessed an application fee for a limited-purpose aquaculture license.
