27 28	Sec. 7. 15 MRSA §393, sub-§1, ¶I, as amended by PL 2015, c. 470, §1, is further amended to read:
29 30	I. Has been discharged from the United States Armed Forces under dishonorable conditions. Violation of this paragraph is a Class \underline{PC} crime; or
31 32	Sec. 8. 15 MRSA §393, sub-§1, ¶J, as amended by PL 2015, c. 470, §1, is further amended to read:
33 34	J. Has, having been a citizen of the United States, renounced that person's citizenship. Violation of this paragraph is a Class $\underline{P} \underline{C}$ crime.

36 37	This bill increases the class of crime for the prohibited possession of a firearm by certain persons.
