1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11208, sub-§1, ¶A,** as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A, §2
3 and affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:

4 A. Shoot at any wild animal or wild bird from any public paved way or within ~~40~~
5 100 feet of the edge from the center of the pavement of the public paved way or from
6 within the right-of-way of any controlled access highway;

7 **Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §11208, sub-§2,** as enacted by PL 2003, c. 655, Pt. B, §139
8 and affected by §422, is amended to read:

9 **2. Penalty.** A person who violates subsection 1 commits a Class E crime for which a
10 fine of \$500 must be adjudged.

11 **Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §11209, sub-§2,** as enacted by PL 2003, c. 655, Pt. B, §140
12 and affected by §422, is amended to read:

13 **2. Penalty.** A person who violates subsection 1 commits a Class E crime for which a
14 fine of \$500 must be adjudged.

15 **Sec. 4. 12 MRSA §11212, sub-§1, ¶B-1** is enacted to read:

16 B-1. A person during the open firearm season on deer may not have in or on a motor
17 vehicle or in or on a trailer or other type of vehicle being hauled by a motor vehicle a
18 firearm with a rifled barrel unless that firearm is enclosed in a case.

19 **Sec. 5. 12 MRSA §11212, sub-§1, ¶C,** as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A, §2
20 and affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:

21 C. A person may not possess a wild animal or wild bird taken in violation of
22 paragraph A ~~or~~ B or B-1, except as otherwise provided in this Part.

23 **SUMMARY**

24 This bill:

25 1. Imposes a mandatory \$500 penalty for a violation of discharging a firearm or
26 crossbow within 100 yards of a building or residential dwelling;

27 2. Increases the minimum distance for discharging a firearm to 100 feet from the
28 center of a paved road and sets a penalty of \$500 for a violation; and

29 3. Requires that a firearm with a rifled barrel in or on a motor vehicle during deer
30 hunting season be enclosed in a case.
