An Act to Improve Long-term Care by Providing Funding for Nursing Facilities

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. Transfer from General Fund unappropriated surplus; Department 3 of Health and Human Services, Nursing Facilities. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, as soon as practicable, the State Controller shall transfer \$50,000,000 4 5 from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Nursing Facilities program, Nursing Facility Reform Transition Fund 6 7 Other Special Revenue Funds account for the purpose of funding components of nursing 8 facility rates.

9 Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and 10 allocations are made.

- 12 **Nursing Facilities 0148**
- 13 Initiative: Provides one-time funding in the Nursing Facility Reform Transition Fund Other 14 Special Revenue Funds account to fund components of nursing facility rates.
