2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §8202, sub-§2, ¶A, as amended by PL 1995, c. 665, Pt. FF,			
3	§1, is further amended to read:			
4 5	A. The amount must be paid in 4 equal quarterly payments during the year of attendance. The first payment must be made by July 31st. The amount of tuition and			
6	other costs paid for all students is limited to the amount appropriated for this purpose.			
7	To be eligible for state funding under this paragraph, a student must have resided reside			
8	in Maine with a parent, other relative or guardian for at least 6 months immediately			
9 10	preceding application to the school at the start of the academic year for which state funding is appropriated.
