### An Act To Facilitate Remote Learning during School Cancellations

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4801, sub-§4** is enacted to read:

3 **4. Online alternative for unscheduled school closures.** If a school day is cancelled  
4 due to weather or another emergency reason, the day is counted as a school day under  
5 subsection 1 if the students of the school receive adequate online instruction pursuant to a  
6 plan agreed upon and adopted by the school board and the superintendent of the school  
7 administrative unit of the school and forwarded to the department. A plan adopted under  
8 this subsection must include an alternative instruction method for a student who does not  
9 have the technical capability to participate in online instruction. The department may  
10 make recommendations on a plan submitted by a school administrative unit under this  
11 subsection and the school administrative unit shall consider the recommendations at the  
12 next scheduled meeting of the unit's school board. A school administrative unit is not  
13 required to accept or implement a recommendation concerning a plan from the  
14 department under this subsection.

15 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill allows a school to receive credit for a school day that is cancelled due to  
17 weather or another emergency reason if the students of the school receive adequate online  
18 instruction or alternative method for students without the technical capability to  
19 participate in online instruction pursuant to a plan agreed upon and adopted by the school  
20 board and the superintendent of the school administrative unit of the school. The school  
21 administrative unit is directed to forward the plan to the Department of Education, which  
22 may make recommendations on the plan. The school administrative unit is not required  
23 to implement a recommendation concerning the plan made by the department.
