1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §621-A, sub-§7 is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	7. Direct deposit of wages. An employer may not charge a fee for the payment of wages by means of direct deposit. For purposes of this section, "direct deposit" means the transfer of wages through electronic funds transfer directly into an employee's account in an accredited financial institution designated by the employee.
7	SUMMARY
8 9	This bill prohibits an employer from charging a fee for the payment of wages to an employee by means of direct deposit of funds.
